



## NOTICE OF EPA PUBLIC MEETING

West Lake Landfill Superfund Site

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reopened the Public Comment period to take comments on the West Lake Landfill Superfund Site Proposed Plan. The reopening will kick off with a **Public Meeting on Thursday, March 27, 2008 from 6:30 p.m. - 8:30 p.m.** at the Bridgeton Community Center, 4201 Fee Fee Road, Bridgeton, Missouri.

The Public Comment period will be open from March 27, 2008 through April 9, 2008. The reopening is due to the number of comments, responses, and inquiries made by the public over the last 1-1/2 years about potential flooding and the security of local levy systems, and their relationship to EPA's proposed remedy. Presentations will be made at the public meeting by staff from the Corps of Engineers and the local levy system, followed by a question-and-answer period.

The Proposed Plan and other site-related documents for the West Lake Landfill Superfund Site are available for review at the Bridgeton Trails Branch of the St. Louis County Library, 3455 McKelvey Road, Bridgeton, Missouri and at the EPA Records Center, 901 North 5th Street, Kansas City, Kansas. Go into the "2006" documents and scroll down until you see "Proposed Plan for the West Lake Landfill Site".

EPA encourages public participation and will not make any final decisions on cleanup alternatives until we have thoroughly reviewed and evaluated comments from the public. Comments may be submitted in writing, electronically, or during the public meeting.
